I want to share all of that with you. I want you to see more than a piece of wood, a bowl of ice cream, or even a leaf.

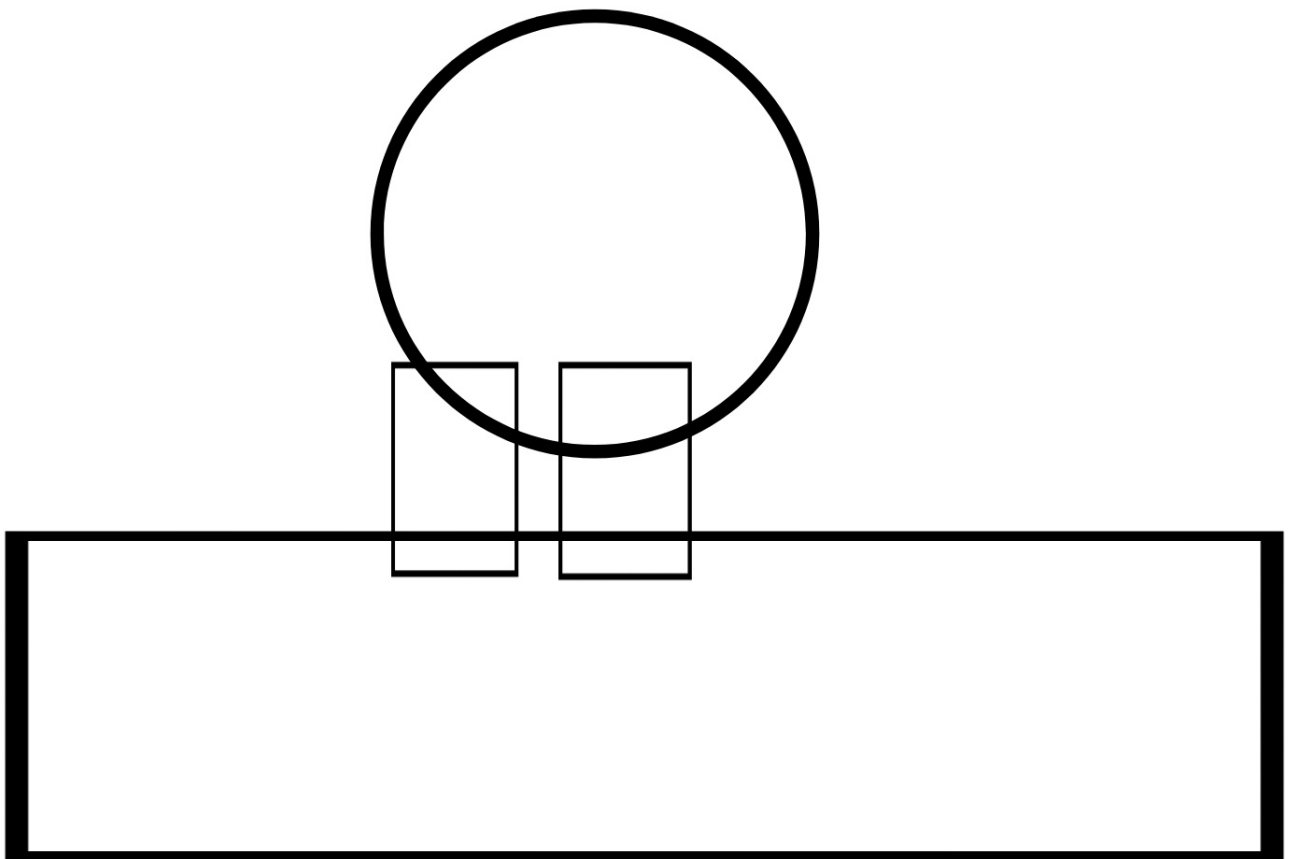
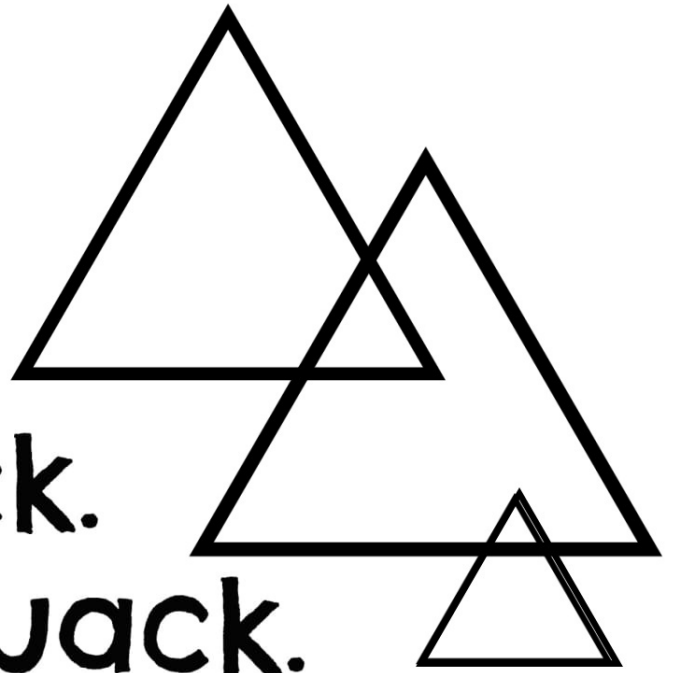
I want you to look at the world in a different way. Spark a piece of your imagination. Find a face and turn it into a story to share with others.

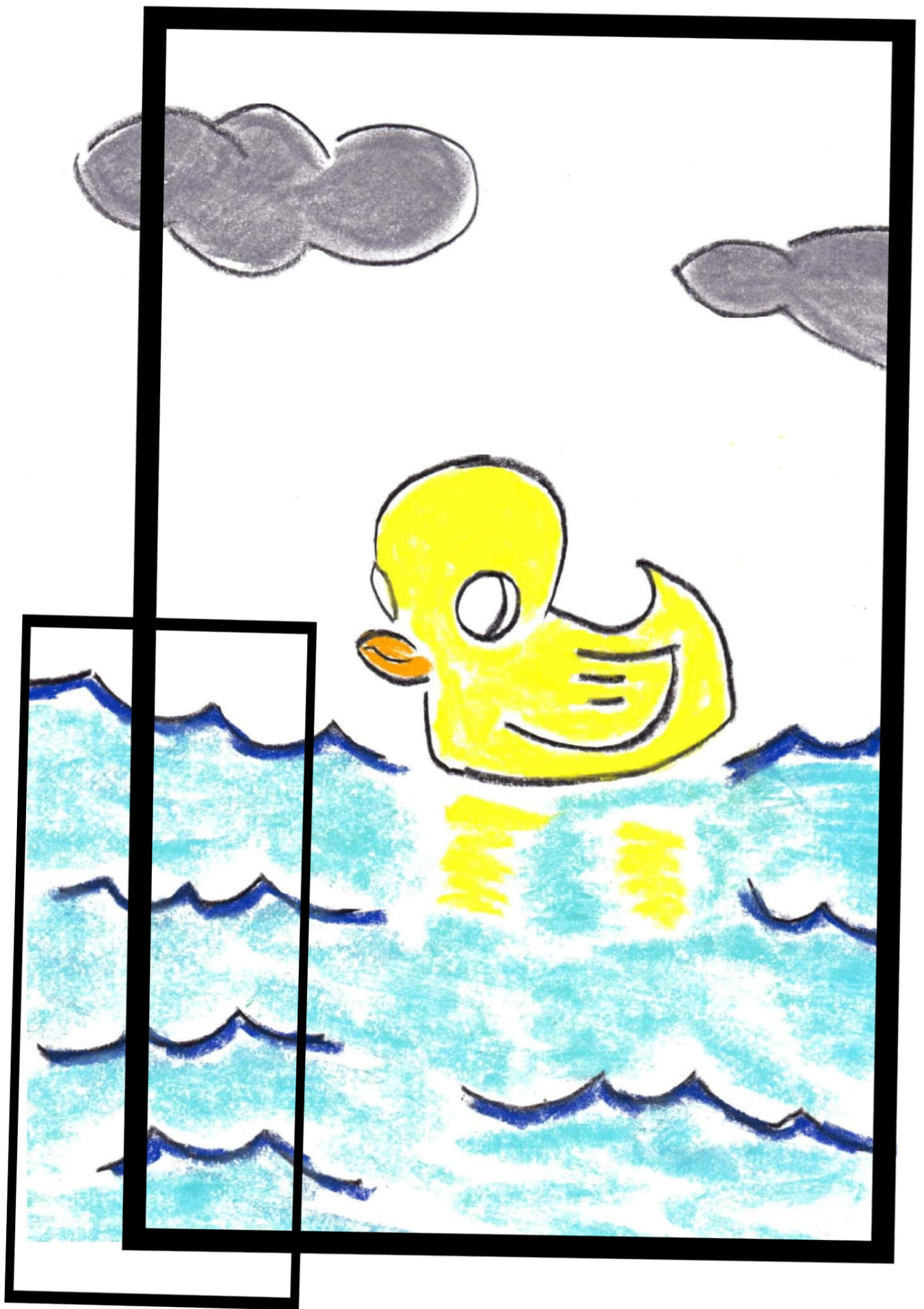
So, take out a pice of paper. Get a Get a pencil, pen, crayons, or markers and as you go through this book, draw what you see. Then go out in the world and see what you can find.
